

Application Guidelines: Duke Study in China Program Summer Research Fellowships:

Application for the fellowship should include the following:

1. The application form.
2. A research proposal no longer than three double-spaced typed pages, with description of the project, including its short-term (for the summer) and long-term objectives, and discussion of research methodology.
3. A budget, including costs of travel, lodging and meals.
4. A statement of support from a faculty member who will supervise the research project.
5. An official Duke transcript.
