

DUSS Summer Camps 2009

The Duke University String School is offering two separate weeks of chamber music camps directed by Dorothy Kitchen. The two camps will take place in June and July. Half day is from 9:00 to 12:00; full day is from 9:00 to 3:00.

Senior instructors are Dorothy Kitchen, Stephanie Swisher, Kathleen Krull, and Sarah Henderson.

Camp I : Monday June 15 through Friday June 19

Camp II: Monday, June 29 through Friday July 3

Concerts are held June 19 and July 3 at 5:30 in Bone Hall.

Camps include technique studies, chamber music, music appreciation, theory, and fun. After lunch, we make a trek out of the building for kick-beach-ball if the weather is good and we have been known to play charades. On Friday, there is a theory bee, a 2 p.m. concert where other DUSS students may play as well as campers, and at 5:30 we present our special program including all that we have learned during the week. The level is mixed and it is essential we have enough students at each level, so we can do our best work.

There is a minimum of 25 students for the camps and a maximum of 40, depending on the levels and the groupings. **Since there is need to have balanced levels, all students must interview with Mrs. Kitchen before camp, unless she has heard the students play.**
