DIRECTIONS

DARK MOUNTAIN TRAILS - 499 Reservoir Road, Wilkesboro, NC

Trails are open to the public year-round for riding. All trails are built and maintained by the Brushy Mountain Cyclists Club with support from the US Army Corps. of Engineers. Please be respectful.

FROM NORTH: Take I-77 South to 421 (just south of Elkin), then follow directions below

FROM SOUTH: Take I-77 North to 421 (just north of Statesville), then follow directions below

GENERAL DIRECTIONS:

Take 421 West from I-77

Take the N.C. 268 exit (exit 286B).

Turn left at the traffic light at the bottom of the exit ramp.

Proceed approximately 3.0 miles.

Turn right onto Reservoir Road; look for a large brown "W. Kerr Scott" directional sign.

Drive across W. Kerr Scott Dam. Park in the lot down the hill to the left.

WARRIOR CREEK (DUAL SLALOM SITE):

From Dark Mountain, leave the Kerr Scott Reservoir and turn right to take N.C. 268 west.

Drive approximately 5.75 miles

Turn right onto Boomer-Ferguson School Road

Turn left into Marley's Ford Recreation Area.

Make an immediate right at the T-intersection, then go approximately one mile.

You will dead-end at the dual slalom course.
