KIPP Infinity students will work harder than they have ever had before. They will attend classes from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day, participate in enrichment activities two Saturdays a month, and attend a three-week Summer Academy. The extra hours will allow students to achieve and surpass grade level standards, preparing them for the nation's finest high schools and colleges. Simply put, higher achievement takes more time and hard work – *no shortcuts!*



Commitment to Excellence

All KIPP Infinity community members sign a Commitment to Excellence contract at the beginning of the year. For teachers, the contract states that they will do *whatever it takes* to ensure that their students are learning. They will be available by phone at night and on the weekends for homework questions and emergencies. For families, the contract states that they will ensure their child does all of his/her homework each night and be an active participant in their child's education. And for students, they pledge that they will work hard, be respectful of their classmates and teachers, and do *whatever it takes* to be a great student. Together, students, families, and teachers create a safe environment committed to excellence—no excuses!

Teamwork

All students are part of the KIPP Infinity team and family. All students will be held to high behavioral expectations so that they and their teammates can learn. Each student will be expected to uphold a culture of respect and achievement. In addition, all KIPP Infinity students will be required to wear uniforms, complete daily homework, and be ready to learn when class begins.

Rigorous Standards

In every grade, KIPP Infinity students will take laboratory-based science classes and read works from a range of authors. Beginning in the sixth grade, all students will begin a formal study of Spanish literacy and literature. Also, all seventh-grade students will begin a course in Algebra.

Enrichment

KIPP Infinity students will participate in enrichment activities on Saturdays that will often involve going out and giving back to the community. Students will learn how to type and format documents in Microsoft Office. Students will also earn the right to participate in field lessons that take them on college visits and to cities such as Washington D.C.
